## **APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS**

The applications are rated as follows: Community Service Activities: 50 points; Essay: 20 points; Grades: 20 points; Recommendation letter: 10 points. Please be sure to submit all required documents along with the completed application form. Incomplete and late submissions will not be considered. All applications remain confidential.

## Required Documents:

- 1. Write an essay (250 words) on your personal response to how the arts can have a positive effect on the community.
- 2. Submit an outline of your past and present volunteer, extra-curricular and work activities in school, the town or your academic community. This should include nonprofit name and address, activity/role you served, years of service, hours per week. Ratings are based on the quality, amount and dedication.
- 3. Submit one (only one) recent letter of recommendation from either a teacher, coach or guidance counselor. The letter should provide some information on your qualities of citizenship and overall character. This person may not be a family member.
- 4. Submit an authenticated copy of your transcript.
- 5. All recipients are required to volunteer with the COMO a minimum of three (3) hours during summer 2025 in support of the 73rd Annual Village Fair, which is a community tradition. Shifts include Friday, August 1st and day of event, Saturday, August 2nd.
